COFFEYVILLE RECREATION COMMISSION CODE OF CONDUCT

The Coffeyville Recreation Commission promotes Sportsmanship, Respect, Integrity and Fair Play in all programs. The CRC has established a CODE OF CONDUCT for everyone involved in our programs. All parents, spectators, guardians are EX-PECTED to know and adhere to the following Standards:

- Remember that these programs are for the Participants, not Spectators or Coaches.
- Spectators must conduct themselves in a manner that would be an example and a Positive Role model to our youth participants and anyone in attendance during our programs and activities.
- Spectators will not argue with Officials, Coaches, Participants or any other spectators.
- Spectators will do their best to learn the rules of the game and reinforce those rules to their children.
- Verbal Abuse or Harassment of Players, Coaches, Officials, Scorekeepers, Security, Facility Directors or other Spectators in any form will not be tolerated.
- Profanity of any kind will not be tolerated

The Coffeyville Recreation Commission reserves the right to take immediate disciplinary action up to removal and expulsion from all facilities for violations of the Code of Conduct. Any of the following actions may be applied when an individual is found to be in violation of Code of Conduct:

- Verbal Warning
- Removal from the facility and or program.
- Expulsion from the facility and all CRC activities (including spectating) for a specific period of time.
- Depending on severity, actions may be turned over to the CPD and the City Attorneys Office.
